



CHÂTEAU HISTOIRE DE FRANCE

CASTILLON - CÔTES DE BORDEAUX



Made on parcels of land at a place called Saint Philippe d'Aiguilhe, this wine combines minerality, fruitiness, roundness and smoothness.



VINEYARD

Area : Bordeaux, Castillon – Côtes de Bordeaux, France

Surface : 4Ha

Soil : mildly thick layers of limestone on hard limestone

Blend : 80 % Merlot, 20 % Cabernet Sauvignon

Method of cultivation : carefully-controlled culture, Guyot double pruning, leaf thinning

WINE MAKING

Harvest : machine harvested

Fermentation : stainless steel vat

Wine ageing : 16 to 18 months in French oak barrels of three wines

TASTING

Robe : rich purple

Nose : fruity and spicy

Taste : smooth with spices notes, slight minerality and silky tannins

Cellar : 5-8 years
